2026 年 3 月 27 日塞浦路斯常驻联合国代表给秘书长的信

奉我国政府指示，谨提请你注意土耳其空军和海军侵犯塞浦路斯领空、违反塞浦路斯飞行情报区国际空中交通管制条例、侵犯塞浦路斯领水以及非法使用塞浦路斯境内非开放港口和机场的一系列新的侵犯和违反行为(见附件)。* 这些侵犯和违反行为是在 2026 年 1 月和 2 月期间记录的，进一步体现了土耳其针对塞浦路斯共和国主权、领土完整和独立的持续非法行动。

正如四个附件所详细说明的那样，在此期间共记录了 305 起空中侵犯事件和 33 起海上侵犯事件。值得注意的是，在这 305 次空中侵犯中，81 次系土耳其军用无人驾驶航空器所为，44 次系土耳其军方武装战斗机所为。此外，土耳其还开展了未经授权的军事演习，侵犯了塞浦路斯共和国领空，并为这些演习非法发布了 4 份航行通告。

上述侵犯行为，加上土耳其占领军几乎每日违反该岛军事现状的行为以及在被占领地区加强军事基础设施的行为，再次表明土耳其完全无视《联合国宪章》和国际法。此类行动也反映了占领国持续的侵略行为，严重损害了所有塞浦路斯人的安全感，同时也阻碍了为恢复全面解决塞浦路斯问题的谈判创造有利条件的努力。

塞浦路斯重申全力支持并坚定不移地致力于由你和你的个人特使开展持续接触，推动恢复谈判，目标是按照安全理事会相关决议的规定，在政治平等的两区两族联邦的基础上达成持久、全面和公正的解决方案。
